Matthew 6:25 "Therefore I tell you, <u>do not worry</u> about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what you will wear. Is not life more important than food, and the body more important than clothes?

²⁶ Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet **your heavenly Father** feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? ²⁷ Who of you by <u>worrying</u> can add a single hour to his life?
