Colossians 2:20 Since you died with Christ to the <u>basic principles</u> <u>of this world</u>, why, as though you still belonged to it, do you submit to its rules...

Colossians 2:21 "Do not handle! Do not taste! Do not touch!"? ²²
These are all destined to perish with use, because they are based
on human commands and teachings.

Colossians 2:23 Such regulations indeed have an appearance of wisdom, with their self-imposed worship, their false humility and their harsh treatment of the body, but they lack any value in restraining sensual indulgence.

The Christ-Centered Solution
F on Christ.
Colossians 2:6 (RSV) As therefore you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so live in him, ⁷ rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.
• As you received so live. v. 6
• As you were rooted be built up. v. 7
• As you were taught be established in the truth. v. 7
Colossians 2:8 See to it that no one takes you <u>captive</u> through <u>hollow</u> and <u>deceptive</u> philosophy, which depends on <u>human</u> tradition and the basic principles of <u>this world</u> rather than <u>on Christ</u> .

<u>F</u> in Christ.

Colossians 2:9 For in Christ all the **fullness** of the Deity

lives in bodily form, ¹⁰ and you have been given <u>fullness in Christ</u>, who is the head over every power and authority.

F with Christ.

Colossians 2:11 In him you were also circumcised, in the putting off of the sinful nature, not with a circumcision done by the hands of men but with the circumcision done by Christ,

Colossians 2:12 ... having been buried with him in baptism and raised with him through your faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead.

F through Christ

Colossians 2:13 When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your sinful nature, <u>God made you alive</u> with Christ.

Romans 5:8 But God demonstrated His love for us in this way: while we were still sinners, Christ died for us!

Colossians 2:13b ... He forgave us all our sins, ¹⁴ having canceled the written code, with its regulations, that was against us and that stood opposed to us; he took it away, nailing it to the cross.

Colossians 2:15 And having disarmed the powers and authorities, he made a public spectacle of them, triumphing over them by the cross.

Colossians 2:16 Therefore do not let anyone judge you by what you eat or drink, or with regard to a religious festival, a New Moon celebration or a Sabbath day.

Colossians 2:18 Do not let anyone who <u>delights in false</u> <u>humility</u> and the worship of angels <u>disqualify you for the</u> <u>prize</u>. Such a person goes into great detail about what he has seen, and <u>his unspiritual mind puffs him up</u> with idle notions.
