

# PRAYER Bible Study

<u>OBJECTIVE</u>: To develop a consistent heart for daily, consistent, believing prayer and to understand what it is, what hinders it, and how do it.

#### PRINCIPLES:

- 1. God commands us to pray constantly--share our heart's desire with Him -- Psalms 62:8
- Real prayer is specifically and confidently asking God for the humanly impossible -- Jeremiah 33:3
- 3. God often limits His work to answering prayer-- James 4:26-- in order to:
  - A. Build faith and love--Psa1ms 116:1, 2
  - B. Glorify His name--John 14:13, 14
  - C. Provide joy--John 16:24
  - D. Provide peace--Philippians 4:6, 7
