Acts 1:8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in Judea and Samaria, and to the uttermost parts of the Earth.

• Salt: Think "Attitude"

■ Matthew 5:13 "You are the salt of the earth. But if the salt loses its saltiness, how can it be made salty again? It is no longer good for anything, except to be thrown out and trampled by men."

• Light: Think "Word"

Acts 26:18"...to open their eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me."

Psalm 119:130 The unfolding of thy word gives light. It imparts understanding to the simple.

Psalm 119:105 Thy word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

John 1:4 In Him was life and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness and the darkness has not extinguished it.

Matthew 5:14 "You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. ¹⁶ In the same way, let your light shine before men, that they may see your good deeds and praise your Father in heaven."
