Exodus: I will do _____ it takes to carry out My plan

1. “I Revealed My _____ to set you free.” (Exodus 1-18)

Two themes:

- (1) Redemption, portrayed in the Passover, and
- (2) Deliverance, portrayed in the Exodus from Egypt.

Exodus Plot #1: Call of Moses (Burning bush; Exodus 1-4)

Exodus Plot #2: the Plagues (Exodus 5-11)

Exodus 6:6 Therefore say to the children of Israel: “I am the Lord; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments.”

Exodus 5:2 “Who is the Lord, that I should obey His voice to let Israel go?”

■ *Ex. 3:19-20 “I know that the king of Egypt will not let you go unless a mighty hand compels him. So I will stretch out my hand and strike the Egyptians with all the wonders that I will perform among them. After that, he will let you go.”*

■ Passover:

■ *Exodus 12:12 “On that same night I will pass through Egypt and strike down every firstborn—both men and animals—and I will bring judgment on all the gods of Egypt. I am the Lord.”*

Exodus 12:13 “The blood will be a sign for you on the houses where you are; and when I see the blood, I will pass over you. No destructive plague will touch you when I strike Egypt.”

Exodus Plot #3: Parting of the Red Sea

■ *Exodus 14:30-31 That day the Lord saved Israel from the hands of the Egyptians, and Israel saw the Egyptians lying dead on the shore. When the Israelites saw the great power the Lord displayed against the Egyptians, the people feared the Lord and put their trust in him and in Moses his servant.*
