1. God Reveals His _____.

*Exodus 19:3 Moses went up [the mountain] to God, and the Lord called to him from the mountain: “This is what you must say to the house of Jacob, and explain to the Israelites: ⁴ ‘You have seen what I did to the Egyptians and **how I carried you on eagles’ wings** and **brought you to Me**. ⁵ Now **if you will listen to Me** and **carefully keep My covenant**, **you will be My own possession out of all the peoples**, although all the earth is Mine, ⁶ and you will be My kingdom of priests and My holy nation.’ These are the words that you are to say to the Israelites.”*

2. God Reveals His _____.

Exodus 19:10 And the Lord told Moses, “Go to the people and purify them today and tomorrow. They must wash their clothes ¹¹ and be prepared by the third day, for on the third day the Lord will come down on Mount Sinai in the sight of all the people. ¹² Put boundaries for the people all around the [mountain] and say: Be careful that you don’t go up on the mountain or touch its base. Anyone who touches the mountain will be put to death.

3. God Reveals His _____ (Law).

Exodus 20:1 Then God spoke all these words: ² 1. I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the place of slavery. ³ Do not have other gods besides Me. ⁴ 2. Do not make an idol for yourself, whether in the shape of anything in the heavens above or on the earth below or in the waters under the earth. ⁵ You must not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the fathers' sin, to the third and fourth [generations] of those who hate Me, ⁶ but showing faithful love to a thousand [generations] of those who love Me and keep My commands. ⁷ 3. Do not misuse the name of the Lord your God, because the Lord will punish anyone who misuses His name. ⁸ 4. Remember to dedicate the Sabbath day: ⁹ You are to labor six days and do all your work, ¹⁰ but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God. You must not do any work—you, your son or daughter, your male or female slave, your livestock, or the foreigner who is within your gates. ¹¹ For the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and everything in them in six days; then He rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and declared it holy. ¹² 5. Honor your father and your mother so that you may have a long life in the land that the Lord your God is giving you. ¹³ 6. Do not murder. ¹⁴ 7. Do not commit adultery. ¹⁵ 8. Do not steal. ¹⁶ 9. Do not give false testimony against your neighbor. ¹⁷ 10. Do not covet your neighbor's house. Do not covet your neighbor's wife, his male or female slave, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

4. God Reveals His _____.

Exodus 20:18 All the people witnessed the thunder and lightning, the sound of the trumpet, and the mountain [surrounded by] smoke. When the people saw [it] they trembled and stood at a distance. ¹⁹ "You speak to us, and we will listen," they said to Moses, "but don't let God speak to us, or we will die." ²⁰ Moses responded to the people, "Don't be afraid, for God has come to test you, so that you will fear Him and will not sin." ²¹ And the people remained standing at a distance as Moses approached the thick darkness where God was.

5. God Reveals _____ IF the People Obey.

*Deuteronomy 28:1 "Now if you **faithfully obey** the Lord your God and are careful to follow all His commands I am giving you today, the Lord your God will put you far above all the nations of the earth. ² All these blessings will come and overtake you, because you obey the Lord your God: ³ You will be blessed in the city and blessed in the country. ⁴ Your descendants will be blessed, and your soil's produce, and the offspring of your livestock, including the young of your herds and the newborn of your flocks.
