## **PURE IN HEART**

Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God

- 3 Hearts
- The Physical Heart
- The Emotional Heart

#### SONG OF SOLOMON

- 3:1 All night long on my bed I looked for the one my **heart** loves; I looked for him but did not find him
- 4:9 You have stolen my **heart**, my sister, my bride; you have stolen my **heart** with one glance of your eyes, with one jewel of your necklace.
- 5:6 but my beloved had left; he was gone. My **heart** sank at his departure. I looked for him but did not find him. I called him but he did not answer.

# The Spiritual Heart

- Genesis 6:5 The Lord saw how great the wickedness of the human race had become on the earth, and that every inclination of the thoughts of the human **heart** was only evil all the time.
- Genesis 8:21 ... Never again will I curse the ground because of humans, even though every inclination of the human **heart** is evil from childhood....
- Exodus 7:13 Yet Pharaoh's **heart** became hard and he would not listen to them, just as the Lord had said.
- Deuteronomy 10:16 Circumcise your hearts, therefore, and do not be stiffnecked any longer.

- Proverbs 4:23 Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.
- Proverbs 11:20 The Lord detests those whose **heart**s are perverse, but he delights in those whose ways are blameless.
- Proverbs 20:9 Who can say, "I have kept my heart pure; I am clean and without sin"?
- Matthew 15:18 But the things that come out of the mouth <u>come from the</u>
   <u>heart</u>, and these make a man 'unclean.' [19] <u>For out of the **heart**</u> come evil
   thoughts, murder, adultery, sexual immorality, theft, false testimony,
   slander.

### "Pure" in Heart

- Jeremiah 17:9 The heart is <u>deceitful</u> above all things and <u>beyond cure</u>.
   <u>Who can understand it</u>?
- Ezekiel 36:26 I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh.
- We need NEW hearts!
- We must be born again, accepting submission to the Spirit of God and He makes us a NEW creation, with a spiritual heart that is alive in Christ
- Once we have a NEW heart; it is then possible to have a PURE heart!
- A PURE heart is Undivided Singly focused on God
- Psalm 86:11 Teach me your way, O Lord, and I will walk in your truth; give me an undivided heart, that I may fear your name.
- Romans 7:21-23 It seems to be a fact of life that when I want to do what is right, I inevitably do what is wrong. [22] I love to do God's will so far as my new nature is concerned; [23] but there is something else deep within me, in my lower nature, that is at war with my mind and wins the fight and makes me a slave to the sin that is still within me. In my mind I want to be God's willing servant, but instead I find myself still enslaved to sin.
- A PURE heart is Clean Set apart for God's purposes

- Rev. 21:27 **Nothing impure** will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but only those whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.
- Hebrews 12:14 Make every effort to live in peace with all men and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.
- "Seeing" God
- Physically

Moses saw God's 'back'

No human (except Jesus) has seen the face of God

1 Timothy 6:15 God, the blessed and only Ruler, the King of kings and Lord of lords, <sup>16</sup> who alone is immortal and who lives in unapproachable light, whom no one has seen or can see. To him be honor and might forever. Amen.

- **Prayer** Psalm 51:10 Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.
- Flee temptation 2 Tim. 2:2 Flee the evil desires of youth, and pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.
- Be accountable to a trusted friend Prov. 13:20 Walk with the wise and become wise, for a companion of fools suffers harm
- **Guard your heart** Prov. 4:23 Above all else, guard your heart, for it is the wellspring of life.
- Col. 3:1-4 Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. [2] Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. [3] For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God. [4] When Christ, who is your life, appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.
