Matthew 5:31 "It has been said, 'Anyone who divorces his

wife must give her a certificate of divorce."

Deuteronomy 24:1 If a man marries a woman who becomes displeasing to him because he finds something <u>indecent</u> about her, and he writes her a certificate of divorce, gives it to her and sends her from his house...

Mark 10:2 Some Pharisees came and <u>tested him</u> by asking, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife?"

Yes, divorce was permitted, but only because of the hardness of man's hearts. Then, Jesus reminds them what God's ideal of marriage looks like.

Divorce, separation and remarriage

Matthew 5:32 But I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for marital unfaithfulness, causes her to become an adulteress, and anyone who marries the divorced woman commits adultery.

1 Corinthians 7:15 But if the unbeliever leaves, <u>let him do so</u>. A believing man or woman is <u>not bound</u> in such circumstances; God has called us to live in peace.

1 Corinthians 7:10- To the married I give this command (not I, but the Lord): A wife must not separate from her husband.

¹¹ But if she does, she must remain unmarried or else be
■ reconciled to her husband. And a husband must not divorce his wife.
