d. Relationally.

1 John 3:14 We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love our brothers. Anyone who does not love remains in death.

e. Destiny.

John 5:24 Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears my word and believes him who sent me, has eternal life; he does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life.

Colossians 2:13 And you, who were dead in trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, <u>God made alive</u> together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, ¹⁴ having canceled the bond which stood against us with its legal demands; this he set aside, nailing it to the cross. ¹⁵ He disarmed the principalities and powers and made a public example of them, triumphing over them in him.
