¹⁵ Perhaps this is why he was parted from you for a while, that you might have him back for ever,

¹⁶ no longer as a slave but more than a slave, as a beloved brother, especially to me but how much more to you, both in the flesh and in the Lord.

¹⁷ So if you consider me your partner, receive him as you would receive me.

¹⁸ If he has wronged you at all, or owes you anything, charge that to my account.

¹⁹ I, Paul, write this with my own hand, I will repay it -- to say nothing of your owing me even your own self.

²⁰ Yes, brother, I want some benefit from you in the Lord. Refresh my heart in Christ.

²¹ Confident of your obedience, I write to you, knowing that you will do even more than I say.

²² At the same time, prepare a guest room for me, for I am hoping through your prayers to be granted to you.

Gentleness

The Fruit of the Spirit—pt. 8 May 31, 2015

Galatians 5:22-23 But the <u>fruit of the Spirit</u> is love, joy, peace, patience, **kindness**, goodness, faithfulness, <u>gentleness</u>, and self-control.

Secular man's real definition of gentleness

Biblical gentleness

"Gentleness" - "Prautes" (Gk.)

Gentleness in the family

Colossians 3:19 <u>Husbands</u>, love your wives, and do not be harsh with them.

Colossians 3:21 <u>Fathers</u>, do not provoke your children, lest they become discouraged.

1 Peter 3:3 Your beauty should not come from outward adornment, such as braided hair and the wearing of gold jewelry and fine clothes.

⁴ Instead, it should be that of your inner self, the unfading beauty of a <u>gentle</u> and quiet <u>spirit</u>, which is of great worth in God's sight. ⁵ For this is the way the holy women of the past who put their hope in God used to make themselves beautiful.

Gentle: difficult situations; with difficult people

1 Thessalonians 2:7 But we were gentle among you, like a nurse taking care of her children.

Galatians 6:1 (RSV) Brothers, if a man is overtaken in a sin, you who are spiritual should <u>restore</u> him in a <u>spirit of</u> <u>gentleness</u>. Look to yourself, lest you too be tempted.

2 Timothy 2:24 And the Lord's servant must not be quarrelsome but kindly to everyone, an apt teacher, forbearing, ²⁵ correcting his opponents with gentleness. God may perhaps grant that they will repent and come to know the truth, ²⁶ and they may escape from the snare of the devil, after being captured by him to do his will.

An amazing example of gentleness: Paul

Philemon 1:7 For I have derived much joy and comfort from your love, my brother, because the hearts of the saints have been refreshed through you.

⁸ Accordingly, though I am bold enough in Christ to command you to do what is required,

⁹ yet for love's sake I prefer to appeal to you -- I, Paul, an ambassador and now a prisoner also for Christ Jesus --

¹⁰ I appeal to you for my child, Ones'imus, whose father I have become in my imprisonment.

¹¹ (Formerly he was useless to you, but now he is indeed useful to you and to me.)

¹² I am sending him back to you, sending my very heart.

¹³ I would have been glad to keep him with me, in order that he might serve me on your behalf during my imprisonment for the gospel;

¹⁴ but I preferred to do nothing without your consent in order that your goodness might not be by compulsion but of your own free will.
