PROVERBS - (ALL OF THEM)

Proverbs 1 describes itself: ² for gaining wisdom and instruction; for understanding words of insight; ³ for receiving instruction in prudent behavior, doing what is right and just and fair; ⁴ for giving prudence to those who are simple, knowledge and discretion to the young — ⁵ let the wise listen and add to their learning, and let the discerning get guidance ⁶ for understanding proverbs and parables, the sayings and riddles of the wise.

PROVERBS 1:7 The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and instruction.
