## WE BUILD PEOPLE

**Hebrews 10:24** And let us consider how we may **spur one another** on toward love and good deeds,

1 Thessalonians 5:11 Therefore encourage one another and build each other up, just as in fact you are doing.

Romans 12:4 For as in one body we have many members,<sup>[e]</sup> and the members do not all have the same function,<sup>5</sup> so we, though many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.

Philemon<sup>10</sup> I appeal to you for my child, Onesimus, whose father I became in my imprisonment.<sup>11</sup> (Formerly he was useless to you, but now he is indeed useful to you and to me.)<sup>12</sup> I am sending him back to you, sending my very heart.

Philemon<sup>13</sup> I would have been glad to keep him with me, in order that he might serve me on your behalf during my imprisonment for the gospel,<sup>14</sup> but I preferred to do nothing without your consent in order that your goodness might not be by compulsion but of your own accord.

Philemon<sup>15</sup> For this perhaps is why he was parted from you for a while, that you might have him back forever,<sup>16</sup> no longer as a bondservant<sup>[b]</sup> but more than a bondservant, as a beloved brother—especially to me, but how much more to you, both in the flesh and in the Lord.

Philemon<sup>17</sup> So if you consider me your partner, receive him as you would receive me.<sup>18</sup> If he has wronged you at all, or owes you anything, charge that to my account.

1 Timothy 4:12 Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.
