## **Understanding the Old Testament**

### The law of Moses: "toothless" and provisional

Romans 7:7 What shall we say, then? Is the law sin? Certainly not! Indeed, I would not have known what sin was except through the law. For I would not have known what coveting really was if the law had not said, Do not covet."

Romans 7:8 But sin, seizing the opportunity afforded by the commandment, produced in me every kind of covetous desire.

## The redemptive movement of scripture

Israel's history; different stages, different demands

1. The wandering clans.

Genesis 10:31 These are the sons of Shem by their clans and languages, in their territories and nations. <sup>32</sup> These are the clans of Noah's sons, according to their lines of descent, within their nations. From these the nations spread out over the earth after the flood.

2. A theocratic people and a theocratic nation.

Genesis 12:2 I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing."

3. Monarchy, the rule of a king. Saul, David, Solomon, etc.

1 Samuel 24:20 "I know that you will surely be king and that the kingdom of Israel will be established in your hands."

■ 4. People of the exile.

Jeremiah 29:10 This is what the LORD says: When seventy years are completed for Babylon, I will come to you and fulfill my gracious promise to bring you back to this place. <sup>11</sup> For I know the plans I have for you, 'declares the LORD, 'blans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. <sup>12</sup> Then you will call upon me and come and pray to me,
