Exodus 3:15 God also said to Moses, "Say to the Israelites, 'The LORD, the God of your fathers--the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob--has sent me to you.' This is my name forever, the name by which I am to be remembered from generation to generation.

¹⁶ "Go, assemble the elders of Israel and say to them, <u>'The LORD,</u> <u>the God of your fathers--the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob--</u> <u>appeared to me</u> and said: I have watched over you and have seen what has been done to you in Egypt.

¹⁷ And I have promised to bring you up out of your misery in Egypt into the land of the Canaanites, Hittites, Amorites, Perizzites, Hivites and Jebusites--a land flowing with milk and honey.'

¹⁸ "The elders of Israel will listen to you. Then you and the elders are to go to the king of Egypt and say to him, 'The <u>LORD, the</u> <u>God of the Hebrews, has met with us</u>. Let us take a three-day journey into the desert to offer sacrifices to the LORD our God.'

¹⁹ But I know that the king of Egypt will not let you go unless a mighty hand compels him.

²⁰ So I will stretch out my hand and strike the Egyptians with all the wonders that I will perform among them. After that, he will let you go.
