Four objections to the wrath of God Objection 1: Why punishment?

Objection 2: Doesn't God forgive everyone?

The wrath of God

2 Thessalonians 1:8 He will punish those who do not know
God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus.
⁹ They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the majesty of his power

1. The wrath of God is precisely that which goes up against evil that must be warned, limited or thwarted.

Deuteronomy 9:7 Remember this and never forget how you provoked the LORD your God to anger in the desert. From the day you left Egypt until you arrived here, you have been rebellious against the LORD.
