(1) Accuse those with whom you disagree of being d. (v. 47)
John 7:48 "Has any of the rulers or of the Pharisees believed in him?"
(2) Point out that the ruling class, the educated, the earlier and intellectuals don't believe (v. 48).
John 7:49 "No! But this mob that knows nothing of the law-there is a curse on them."
(3) <u>D</u> those who believe. (v. 49)
(4) Accuse those who do believe of being I and uneducated (v. 49).
(5) Accuse them of being controlled by <u>e</u> (v. 49).
John 7:52 They replied, "Are you from Galilee, too? Look into it, and you will find that a prophet does not come out of Galilee."
(6) Assume only you have all the <u>f</u> .
(7) Assume that your facts are all <u>c</u> and none other need to be considered (v.52).

- Hate, because He called people on their sin (7)
- "Demon-possessed" (20)
- Accused Him of breaking the Sabbath when He healed the paralytic (23)
- Couldn't be the Messiah. We know where He's from (27)
- Tried to seize Him, but failed (30)

# Jesus, the Water of Life

John 7:37 On the last and greatest day of the Feast, Jesus stood and said in a loud voice, "<u>If anyone is thirsty</u>, let him come to me and drink. <sup>38</sup> Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, streams of living water will flow from within him."

John 7:39 By this he meant the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were later to receive....

Revelation 22:17 The Spirit and the bride say, "Come!" And let him who hears say, "Come!" Whoever is thirsty, let him come; and whoever wishes, let him take the free gift of the water of life.

### Question #1: For what are we thirsty?

Isaiah 58:11 The LORD will guide you always; he will <u>satisfy</u> your needs in a sun-scorched land and will strengthen your frame. You will be like a <u>well-watered garden</u>, like a <u>spring</u> whose waters never fail.

Psalms 143:1 O LORD, hear my prayer, listen to my cry for mercy; in your <u>faithfulness</u> and <u>righteousness</u> come to my <u>relief</u>. <sup>2</sup> Do not bring your servant into judgment, for no one living is righteous before you.

<sup>3</sup> The enemy pursues me, he crushes me to the ground; he makes me dwell in darkness like those long dead.

<sup>4</sup> So my <u>spirit grows faint</u> within me; <u>my heart within me is dismayed.</u>

<sup>5</sup> I remember the days of long ago; I meditate on all your works and consider what your hands have done.

<sup>6</sup> I spread out my hands to you; my soul thirsts for you like a parched land.

#### Question #2: What can quench our human thirst?

<sup>5</sup> They were hungry and thirsty, and their lives ebbed away.

<sup>8</sup>Let them give thanks to the LORD for his unfailing love and his wonderful deeds for men,

<sup>9</sup> for <u>he satisfies the thirsty</u> and <u>fills the hungry with good</u> **t**hings.
