John 16:21 A woman giving birth to a child has pain because her time has come; but when her baby is born she forgets the anguish because of her joy that a child is born into the world. <sup>22</sup> So with you: Now is your time of grief, but I will see you again and you will rejoice, and no one will take away your joy.

The kind of "joy" the world offers is circumstantial. The kind of joy Jesus offers us is transformational.

### A different kind of peace

John 16:31 "Do you now believe?" Jesus replied. <sup>32</sup> "A time is coming and in fact has come when you will be scattered, each to your own home. You will leave me all alone. Yet I am not alone, for my Father is with me."

John 16:33 "I have told you these things, so that in me you may have peace. In this world you will have trouble. But take heart! I have overcome the world."

### **Hatred of Christianity**

John 15:18 "If the world hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. <sup>19</sup> If you belonged to the world, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the world. but I have chosen you out of the world. That is why ■ the world hates you. <sup>20</sup> Remember what I told you: 'A servant is not greater than his master.' t If they persecuted me, they will persecute you also. If they obeyed my teaching, they will obey yours also. <sup>21</sup> They will treat you this way because of my name, for they do not know the one who sent me. <sup>22</sup> If I had not come and spoken to them, they would not be guilty of sin; but now they have no excuse for their sin. <sup>23</sup> Whoever hates me hates my Father as well. <sup>24</sup> If I had not done among them the works no one else did, they would not be guilty of sin. As it is, they have seen, and yet they have hated both me and my Father. <sup>25</sup> But this is to fulfill what is written in their Law: 'They hated me without reason.'

John 16:1 "All this I have told you so that you will not fall away. <sup>2</sup> They will put you out of the synagogue; in fact, the time is coming when anyone who kills you will think they are offering a service to God. <sup>3</sup> They will do such things because they have not known the Father or me. <sup>4</sup> I have told you this, so that when their time comes you will remember that I warned you about them."

#### The "world"

John 15:18 "If the <u>world</u> hates you, keep in mind that it hated me first. <sup>19</sup> If you belonged to the <u>world</u>, it would love you as its own. As it is, you do not belong to the <u>world</u>, but I have chosen you out of the <u>world</u>. That is why the <u>world</u> hates you.

1 John 2:15-17 Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes and the pride of life is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world passes away and the lust of it but he who does the will of God abides forever.

### \_ The Holy Spirit

John 15:26 "When <u>the Advocate</u> comes, whom I will send to you from the Father—the Spirit of truth who goes out from the Father—<u>he</u> will testify about me. <sup>27</sup> And you also must testify, for you have been with me from the beginning.

The Advocate: "parakletos" -

John 16:7 But very truly I tell you, it is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Advocate will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. When he comes, he

will prove the world to be in the wrong about sin and righteousness and judgment: <sup>9</sup> about sin, because people do not believe in me; <sup>10</sup> about righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; <sup>11</sup> and about judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned.

John 16:13 "...when he, the **Spirit of truth**, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. <sup>14</sup> He will glorify me because it is from me that he will receive what he will make known to you. <sup>15</sup> All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the Spirit will receive from me what he will make known to you."

## A different kind of joy

John 16:19 ... "Are you asking one another what I meant when I said, 'In a little while you will see me no more, and then after a little while you will see me'?"

John 16:20 "Very truly I tell you, you will weep and mourn while the world rejoices. You will grieve, but your grief will turn to joy."

Psalm 126:6 Those who go out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying sheaves with them.
