God Relating "In" People Christ is after our <u>heart</u>.

Romans 7:15 I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do.

Case study with Cain

The example of Jesus--moving our hearts

Luke 7:36 Now one of the Pharisees invited Jesus to have dinner with him, so he went to the Pharisee's house and reclined at the table.

- ³⁹ When the Pharisee who had invited him saw this, he <u>said</u> to <u>himself</u>, "If this man were a prophet, he would know who is touching him and what kind of woman she is... she is a sinner."
- Jesus answered him, "Simon, I have something to tell you." "Tell me, teacher," he said. 41 "Two men owed money to a certain moneylender. One owed him five hundred denarii, and the other fifty.
 - ⁴² Neither of them had the money to pay him back,
- ...so he canceled the debts of both.

Now which of them will love him more?" ⁴³ Simon replied, "I suppose the one who had the bigger debt canceled." "You have judged correctly," Jesus said.

- "Do you see this woman? I came into your house. You did not give me any water for my feet, but she wet my feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair.
 - ⁴⁵ You did not give me a kiss, but this woman, from the time I entered, has not stopped kissing my feet.
 ⁴⁶ You did not put oil on my head, but she has poured perfume on my feet.
 - ⁴⁷ Therefore, I tell you, her many sins have been forgiven-for she loved much. But he who has been forgiven little loves little." ⁴⁸ Then Jesus said to her, "Your sins are forgiven." ⁴⁹ The other guests began to say among themselves, "Who is this who even forgives sins?" ⁵⁰ Jesus said to her, "Your faith has saved you; go in peace."

³⁷ When a woman who had lived a sinful life in that town learned that Jesus was eating at the Pharisee's house, <u>she brought an alabaster jar of perfume</u>, ³⁸ and as she stood behind him at his feet weeping, she began to wet his feet with her tears.
