• The pursuit of pleasure

Ecclesiastes 1:1 The words of the Teacher, son of David, king in Jerusalem: ² "Meaningless! Meaningless!" says the Teacher. "Utterly meaningless! Everything is meaningless."

Proverbs 17:24 A discerning person keeps wisdom in view, but a fool's eyes wander to the ends of the earth.

Jeremiah 14:10 This is what the LORD says about this people: "They greatly love to wander; they do not restrain their feet. So, the LORD does not accept them; he will now remember their wickedness and punish them for their sins."

...an invitation to deeper desires

John 4:13 Jesus answered, "Everyone who drinks this water will be thirsty again, ¹⁴ but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life."

Matthew 5:6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they will be filled.

Character formation. Living on the basis of His love, living like Christ and loving like Christ define our deepest life.

Philippians 3:8 ... I consider everything a loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord, for whose sake I have lost all things. I consider them garbage, that I may gain Christ 9 and be found in him, not having a righteousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which is through faith in Christ—the righteousness that comes from God on the basis of faith.

Our greatest joys come from:

- -Learning to live like He did (character formation)
- -Finding our satisfaction in God (spiritual formation)
- -Reflecting His love to the people around us, (relational formation)

Isaiah 55:1 "Come, all you who are thirsty, come to the waters; and you who have no money, come, buy and eat! Come, buy wine and milk without money and without cost.

² Why spend money on what is not bread, and your labor on what does not <u>satisfy</u>? Listen, listen to me, and eat what is good, and you will delight in the richest of fare. ³ Give ear and come to me; listen, <u>that you may live</u>.

Finding our satisfaction in God:

- a. We experience a deeper satisfaction in God on occasion.
- b. He wants to create a greater _____for satisfaction in relation to Him.

It is not the experience with God that He is after. It is a thirst for God that matters.
