Prov. 29:25 *Fear of man will prove to be a snare, but whoever trusts in the LORD is kept safe.*

The Blessing of Trust

Jeremiah 17:5 This is what the LORD says: "Cursed is the one who trusts in man, who draws strength from mere flesh and whose heart turns away from the LORD.

⁶ That person will be like a bush in the wastelands; they will not see prosperity when it comes. They will dwell in the parched places of the desert, in a salt land where no one lives.

⁷ "But blessed is the one who trusts in the LORD, whose confidence is in him.⁸ They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit."

Obey His Commands.
