Ecclesiastes 3:14 <u>I know that whatever God does endures</u> <u>forever</u>; nothing can be added to it, nor anything taken from it; God has made it so, in order that men should fear before him. ¹⁵ That which is, already has been; that which is to be, already has been; and God seeks what has been driven away.

Discouragement: On what am I depending for real life?

Exodus 20:3 You shall have no other gods before me.⁴ "You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. ⁵ You shall not bow down to them or worship them;

The choice before us: Trust & act in spite of your feelings

2 Chronicles 20:15 <u>Do not be afraid or discouraged because</u> of this vast army. For the battle is not yours, but God's.

¹⁶ Tomorrow march down against them. ¹⁷ You will not have to fight this battle. Take up your positions; stand firm and see the deliverance the LORD will give you... **Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged**. Go out to face them tomorrow, and <u>the LORD</u> will be with you.'

Feelings do not need to rule us

God is serving His purposes through this trial

Act on what is right. Do your responsibility. Act with courage.

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The Surprising Virtue of Discouragement

Satisfied-part 3

April 14, 2024

Proverbs 27:20 Hell and destruction are never satisfied, and <u>never satisfied</u> are the eyes of man.

Discouragement: is there anything really worth living for?

Ecclesiastes 1:2 "Vanity of vanities, says the Preacher, vanity of vanities! All is vanity."

Romans 1:18 The wrath of God is being revealed from heaven against all the godlessness and wickedness of men who suppress the truth by their wickedness, ¹⁹ since what may be known about God is plain to them, because God has made it plain to them.²⁰ For since the creation of the world God's *invisible qualities--his eternal power and divine nature--have* been clearly seen, being understood from what has been made, so that men are without excuse.²¹ For although they knew God, they neither glorified him as God nor gave thanks to him, but their thinking became futile and their foolish hearts were darkened. ²² Although they claimed to be wise, they became fools²³ and exchanged the glory of the immortal God for images made to look like mortal man and birds and animals and reptiles.²⁵ They exchanged the truth of God for a lie, and worshiped and served created things rather than the Creator--who is forever praised. Amen.

Discouragement: stinkin' thinkin'

Ecclesiastes 1:3 What does man gain by all the toil at which he toils under the sun?

⁴ A generation goes, and a generation comes, but the earth remains forever.

⁵ The sun rises and the sun goes down, and hastens to the place where it rises.

⁶ The wind blows to the south, and goes round to the north; round and round goes the wind, and on its circuits the wind returns. ⁷ All streams run to the sea, but the sea is not full; to the place where the streams flow, there they flow again.

⁸ All things are full of <u>weariness</u>; a man cannot utter it; the eye is <u>not satisfied</u> with seeing, nor the ear filled with hearing.

⁹ What has been is what will be, and what has been done is what will be done; and there is nothing new under the sun. ¹⁰ Is there a thing of which it is said, "See, this is new"? It has been already, in the ages before us.

¹¹ There is no remembrance of former things, nor will there be any remembrance of later things yet to happen among those who come after.

> Are you drawing conclusions about life from a horizontal, finite, and temporal or vertical, infinite, and eternal point of view?

Discouragement: "I can't make any sense out of this."

Speculation vs. Revelation

Eccl. 1:13 And <u>I applied my mind</u> to seek and to search out by wisdom all that is done under heaven; it is an unhappy business that God has given to the sons of men to be busy with. ¹⁴ <u>I have seen everything</u> that is done under the sun; and behold, all is vanity and a striving after wind. ¹⁵ What is crooked cannot be made straight, and what is lacking cannot be numbered. ¹⁶ I said to myself, "<u>I have acquired</u> <u>great wisdom</u>, surpassing all who were over Jerusalem before me; and <u>my mind</u> has had great experience of wisdom and knowledge." ¹⁷ And I applied my mind to know wisdom and to know madness and folly. I perceived that this also is but a striving after wind. ¹⁸ For in <u>much wisdom</u> is <u>much vexation</u>, and he who increases knowledge increases <u>sorrow</u>.

The (daily) redemption of discouragement

Encouragement: God is redemptively at work in daily life

Romans 8:28 We know that in everything God works for the good of those who love Him, who are called according to His purpose. ²⁹ For those He foreknew He also predestined to be conformed to the image of His Son...

Ecclesiastes 3:1 For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven:

² a time to be born, and a time to die; a time to plant, and a time to pluck up what is planted;

³ a time to kill, and a time to heal; a time to break down, and a time to build up;

⁴ a time to weep, and a time to laugh; a time to mourn, and a time to dance;

⁵ a time to cast away stones, and a time to gather stones together; a time to embrace, and a time to refrain from embracing;

⁶ a time to seek, and a time to lose; a time to keep, and a time to cast away; ⁷ a time to rend, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak; ⁸ a time to love, and a time to hate; a time for war, and a time for peace. ⁹ What gain has the worker from his toil? ¹⁰ I have seen the business that <u>God has</u> <u>given</u> to the sons of men to be busy with.

Ecclesiastes 3:11 He has <u>made everything beautiful</u> in its time; also <u>he has put eternity into man's mind</u>, yet so that he cannot find out what God has done from the beginning to the end.

Ecclesiastes 3:12 I know that there is nothing better for them than to be happy and enjoy themselves as long as they live; ¹³ *also that it is God's gift to man that everyone should eat and drink and take pleasure in all his toil.*
