Philippians 2:10-11 ...that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

#### **Conclusion:**

■ 1 Cor. 1:30 It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and <u>redemption</u>.

1 Cor. 6:19-20 You are not your own; you were bought at a price.

### Redemption

Ephesians 1:7 <u>In Him we have redemption</u> through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace

Redemption:

#### Four parts of redemption:

- Predicament.
- Purchaser.
- Purchase.
- Price.

#### **Biblical meanings of redemption**

Agorazo: (Gk.) Marketplace.

1 Peter 1:18-19 You know it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were redeemed from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers,

Eph. 2:1 As for you, you were dead in your transgressions and sins, <sup>2</sup> in which you used to live when you followed the ways of this world and of the ruler of the kingdom of the air, the spirit who is now at work in those who are disobedient. <sup>3</sup> All of us also lived among them at one time,

gratifying the cravings of our flesh and following its desires and thoughts. Like the rest, we were by nature deserving of wrath.

**Exagorazo:** to buy *out of* the marketplace.

Titus 2:14 ...who gave Himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for Himself a people that are His very own, eager to do what is good.

"Luo"- to loose or set free.

Kofer: (Heb.) A ransom price.

Matthew 20:28 ...the Son of Man did not come to be served but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many.

## Why is blood the price of redemption?

#### The fellowship of the redeemed

Ephesians 1:10 ...to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ.

Philippians 2:9 Therefore, God exalted Him to the highest place and gave Him the name that is above every name...
