Eph. 1:19-20 ... That power is like working of His mighty strength, which He exerted in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly realms ...

Eph. 1:21-22 ... far above all rule and authority, power and dominion, and every title that can be given, not only in the present age but also in the one to come. And God placed all things under His feet and appointed Him to be head over everything.

The need for divine power:

Matt. 13:13 seeing they don't see and hearing they don't hear.

Petition #1: to know God better

Ephesians 1:17 ... so that you may know Him better.

Petition #2: to know the hope of God's calling

Ephesians 1:18 I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you...

What does Paul mean by God's calling?

Philippians 3:14 I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

2 Tim. 1:9 ... who has saved us and called us to a holy life...

1 Thess. 2:12 ...encouraging, comforting and urging you to live lives worthy of God, who calls you into his Kingdom and glory.

1 Peter 5:10 And after you have suffered a little while, the God of grace, who has called you to his eternal glory in Christ, will himself restore establish and strengthen you.

Hope:

Hope #1: Assurance; an expectant attitude.

Hope #2: the substance of what we will experience in the future.

Petition #3: to know the riches of God's inheritance

Eph. 1:18 ... know the riches of the glorious inheritance in the saints...

Judges 6:12 The Lord is with you, mighty warrior...

John 1:42 You are called Simon... you shall be called Peter (rock).

Petition #4: to know the greatness of God's power

Eph. 1:19-20 ...and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is like working of His mighty strength, which He exerted in...

Dunamis- power, dynamo, dynamite

Energeia- working, energy

Kratos- mighty

Ischus- power, strength
