
Darkness is serious business

Eph. 5:5 For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person--such a man is an idolater--has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.

Eph. 5:6 Let no one deceive you with empty words, for because of such things God's wrath comes on those who are disobedient.⁷ Therefore do not be partners with them.

Living in the light

1. Once you *were* darkness; now you are light.

Ephesians 5:8... for once you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord...

2. Because we are light, we live light.

Ephesians 5:8... for once you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord; walk as children of light.

Eph. 5:9 (for the fruit of light is found in all that is good and right and true),¹⁰ and try to learn what is pleasing to the Lord.

3. Don't dabble in darkness.

Eph. 5:11 Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead expose them.

Eph. 5:12 For it is a shame even to speak of the things that they do in secret;

Eph. 5:13 But everything exposed by the light becomes visible,¹⁴ for it is light that makes everything visible. This is why it is said: "Wake up, O sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you."

Ephesians review:

Eph. 1: God chose, redeemed, sealed and empowers you.

Eph. 2: Man's predicament, But God saved you... even us!

Ephesians 5:1 Be imitators of God, ...

"Mimitate" -

NEW IDENTITY

Ephesians 5:1 Be imitators of God, therefore, as dearly loved children² and live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

NEW PRIORITY #1: LIVE A LIFE OF LOVE

Ephesians 5:2 ...live a life of love, just as Christ loved us and gave himself up for us as a fragrant offering and sacrifice to God.

Matt. 5:43-48 You have heard that it was said, 'You shall

love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' ⁴⁴ But I say to you, Love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, ⁴⁵ so that you may be children of your Father in heaven; for he makes his sun rise on the evil and on the good, and sends rain on the righteous and on the unrighteous. ⁴⁶ For if you love those who love you, what reward do you have? Do not even the tax collectors do the same? ⁴⁷ And if you greet only your brothers and sisters, what more are you doing than others? Do not even the Gentiles do the same?

- **An undeserved love.**

Romans 5:6 While we were still weak, at the right time Christ **died** for **the ungodly**. ⁷ Why, one will hardly die for a righteous man -- though perhaps for a good man one will dare even to die. ⁸ But **God shows his love** for us in that while we were yet **sinner**s Christ died for us.

"...as a fragrant offering..."

- **An intentional love.**

"...live a life of love..."

Romans 13:9 The **commandments**, "Do not commit adultery," "Do not murder," "Do not steal," "Do not covet," and whatever other **commandment** there may be, are summed up in this one **rule**: "Love your neighbor as yourself."

- **A sacrificial love.**

"...just as Christ loved us and gave Himself up for us"

Ephesians 5:3 But among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed, because these are improper for God's holy people.
