## Headship

### **Principles:**

Ephesians 5:22 Wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands as you do to the Lord. <sup>23</sup> For <u>the husband is the head of the wife</u> as <u>Christ is the head of the church</u>, his body, of which he is the Savior.

1 Corinthians 11:3 But I want you to realize that the head of every man is Christ, and the head of the woman is man, and the head of Christ is God.

Matthew 20:25 You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them. <sup>26</sup> Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, <sup>27</sup> and whoever wants to be first must be your slave— <sup>28</sup> just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many."

#### **Model:**

Phil. 2:5 In your relationships with one another, <u>have the</u> <u>same mindset as Christ Jesus</u>:

- <sup>6</sup> Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be used to his own advantage; <sup>7</sup> rather, he <u>made himself nothing</u> by <u>taking</u> the very nature of a servant, being made in human
- the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to death— even death on a cross!

### Sacrificial love

Ephesians 5:25 Husbands, love your wives, <u>just as Christ</u> loved the church and <u>gave himself up</u> for her <sup>26</sup> to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, <sup>27</sup> and to present her to himself as a radiant church,

■ without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. <sup>28</sup> In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies.

### **Tender love**

Ephesians 5:28 In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.
